CHIPIG is the Consumer Health Information Providers Group, a formal group of health professionals and librarians who meet to share ideas and resources. The group started informally in the fall of 1999, and worked to host a one-day conference titled "Consumer Health Information: The Canadian Experience". This was held in conjunction with the second conference on Family Resource Centres in Toronto in June 2001.

As the name states we are Information Providers, who specialize in providing health information to consumers. Some of us work in health care settings, such as hospitals or clinics, while others work in libraries or other agencies that provide information.

We meet about every two months, usually in a different members site. Our meeting focus on sharing information about our programs, new resources we have found, and any new developments in the field of consumer health information. We also use our electronic list serv to share this information between meetings.

The CHIPIG group has seen a considerable expansion in the past few months, as we became an affiliate member of the **Canadian Health Libraries Association (CHLA)**, hosted

a well-attended walking tour of consumer health centres at the 2005 CHLA meeting in Toronto, and recruited new members from beyond our traditional "southern Ontario" boundaries.

The CHIPIG vision is to become a network of health information providers in hospitals, public libraries, and organizations, across Canada who improve the health of our communities through the education and empowerment of consumers.

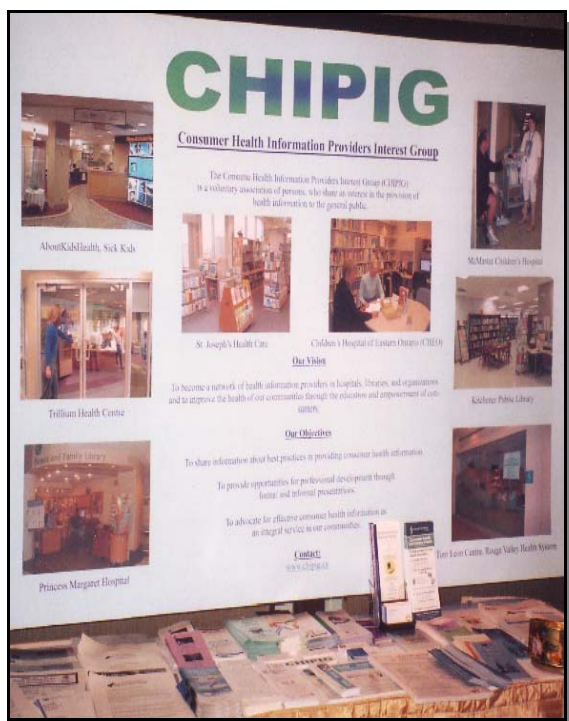
CHIPIG CONNECTIONS
