

MILITARY, RENNIE'S MILL, EMPIRE LOOP

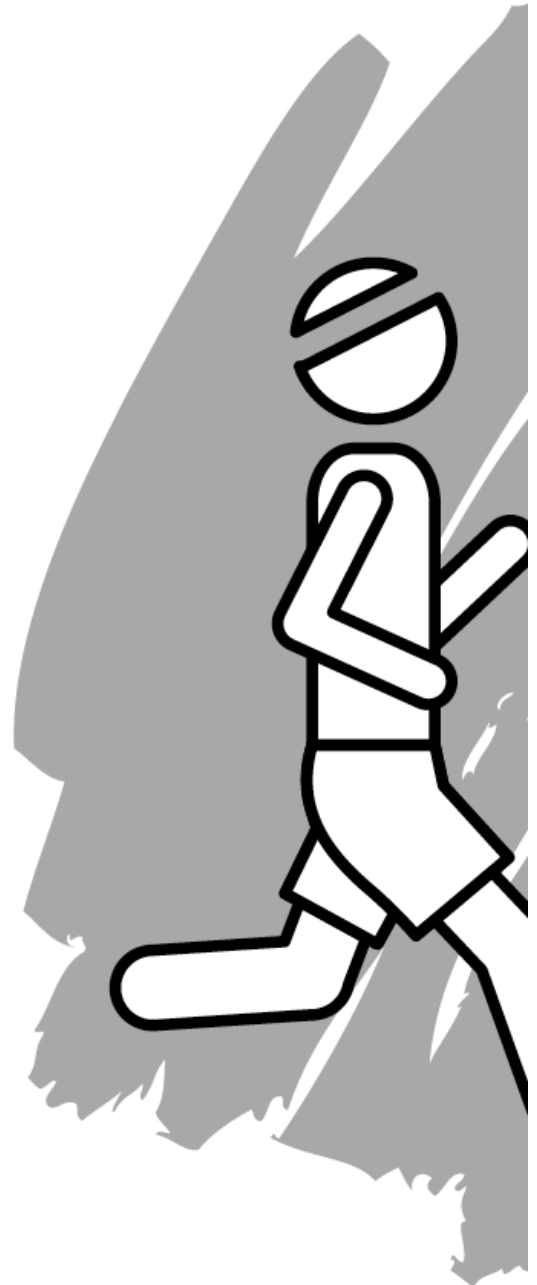
2.2 km / Approx. 30 minutes (walking)

*This is a flat walk, mostly on sidewalks,
through a historic area of St. John's.*

1. Head northwest on Cavendish Square (29 m)
2. Slight left onto Military Rd (500 m)
3. Head southwest on Military Rd toward Carew St (130 m)
4. You'll pass Bannerman Park on your right. Also on your right is the Colonial Building, which was the home of the Newfoundland government and the House of Assembly from January 28, 1850 to July 28, 1959. In 1974 it was declared a provincial historic site.
5. Turn right onto Rennies Mill Rd (24 m)
6. Slight right to stay on Rennies Mill Rd (450 m)
7. Head north on Rennies Mill Rd toward Empire Ave (35 m)
8. Turn right onto Empire Ave (280 m)
9. Head east on Empire Ave toward Circular Rd (300 m)
10. Turn right onto Kings Bridge Rd (62 m)
11. On your right, at the corner of Kings Bridge & Military, you'll pass Commissariat House, a provincial historic site, which was built between 1818-1820 as the home and offices of the Assistant Commissary General, the supply officer for British forces in Newfoundland.
12. Continue along Kings Bridge Rd
13. Slight left onto Cavendish Square
